Re-sit Policy

Rights to Resit

1. General Principles

- 1.1. A resit is defined as a second attempt at an assessment component of a module following failure at the first attempt. An assessment component may be an examination or any other form of summative assessment such as a written assignment, oral examination etc.
- 1.2. Resits are granted in accordance with these regulations and are subject to any maximum credit limits specified below.
- 1.3. All resit marks are capped at the pass mark for the level of study.
- 1.4. Resits will normally take place at the next scheduled assessment period. This is usually after your original mark has been confirmed by the summer Assessment Board, meaning you'll know your official result before attempting the resit.
- 1.5. Students may not be permitted a resit where they have already exhausted their entitlement under the Common Award Core regulations.
- 1.6. No student may re-sit an assessment component in which he/she has achieved a mark of 40% or more at the first attempt.
- 1.7. Students who have failed modules, have exhausted any resit opportunities, and cannot progress, are required to exit with an alternative award.

MA in Theology, Ministry and Mission	1 resit for modules failed at the first attempt, up to 60 credits (half programme total, excluding the dissertation)	1 resubmission permitted
MA in Contemporary Christian Leadership	1 resit for taught modules failed at the first attempt, up to 60 credits (half programme total, excluding the dissertation)	1 resubmission permitted

Note: Students are permitted to re-sit one or more module elements and may do so on one occasion only (see point 59 of Core Regulations [both for UG and PG postgraduates] for more details).

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
