<b>A. Knowledge &amp; Understanding</b>	
<b>A1</b>	Advanced and thorough understanding of parts of Scripture, their relationship to the whole, and how to interpret them in different cultural contexts
<b>A2</b>	Systematic and advanced understanding of selected doctrines of the Christian faith and/or periods of church history and historical theology, and their significance for the contemporary church worldwide
<b>A3</b>	Advanced understanding of how the Christian faith engages with contemporary ethical and pastoral issues across cultures
<b>A4</b>	Advanced understanding of the interconnectedness of elements within the study of theology globally
<b>A5</b>	Thorough understanding of the methodologies and techniques used in the study of theology globally

<b>B. Cognitive (Thinking) Skills</b>	
<b>B1</b>	Critical and reflective evaluation of advanced scholarship in the theological disciplines, applying a variety of critical methods, assessing views and theories and, where appropriate, proposing alternatives
<b>B2</b>	Evaluation of methodologies employed in the theological disciplines and missiological practices, and development of critiques
<b>B3</b>	Construction and articulation of an integrative, coherent, well-informed, critically engaged and sustained argument and development of original application of the knowledge and understanding it contains

<b>C1</b>	Articulation of systematic and creative responses to typical issues arising in Christian theology and ministry both cross-culturally in the UK and internationally
